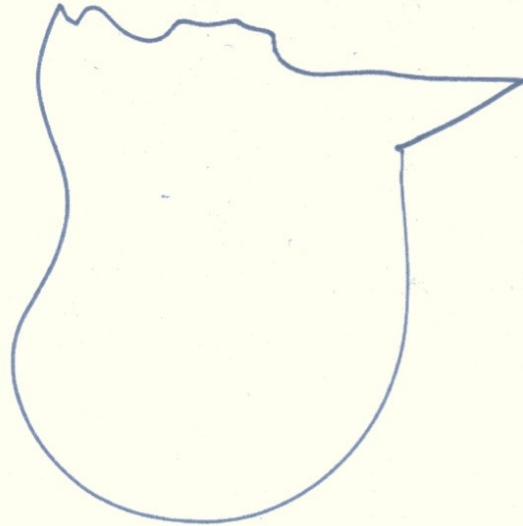
Play the SHAPE GAME

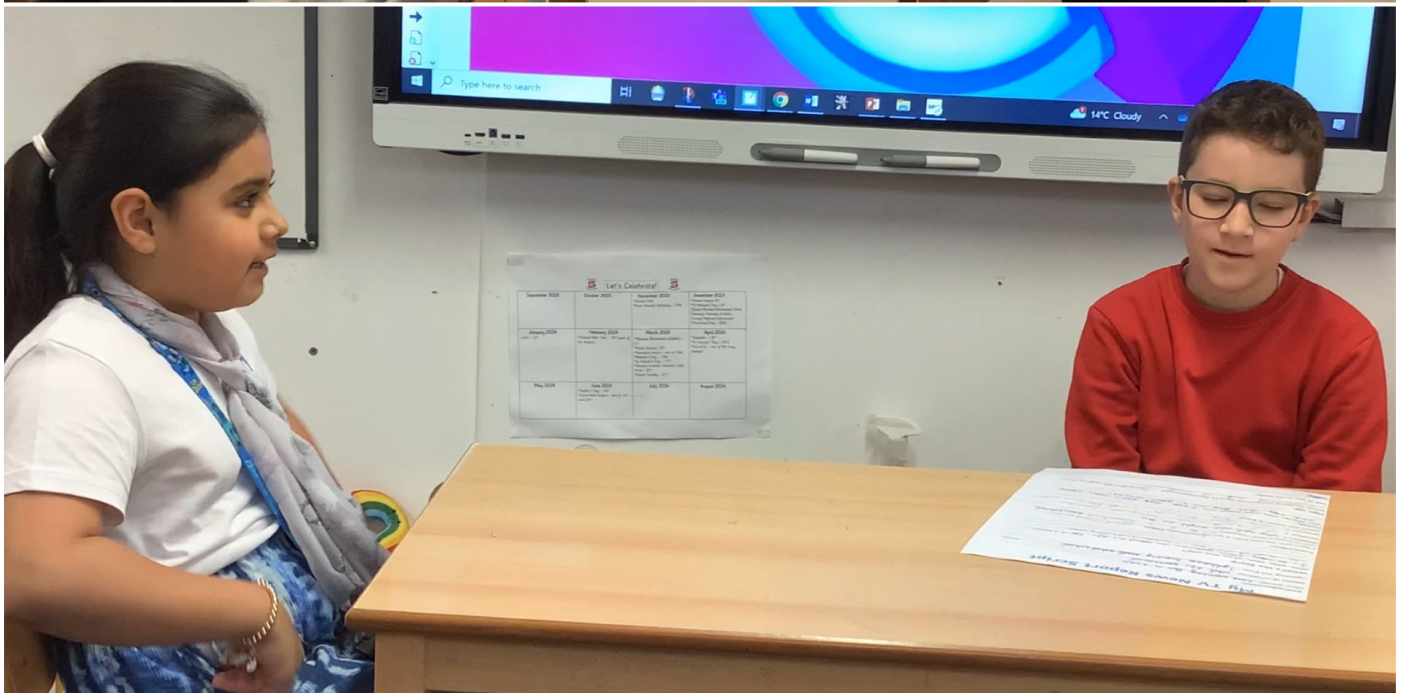

This week, Year Four have been investigating and reporting upon a crime scene . You can find more exclusive information about this breaking news on the next page.

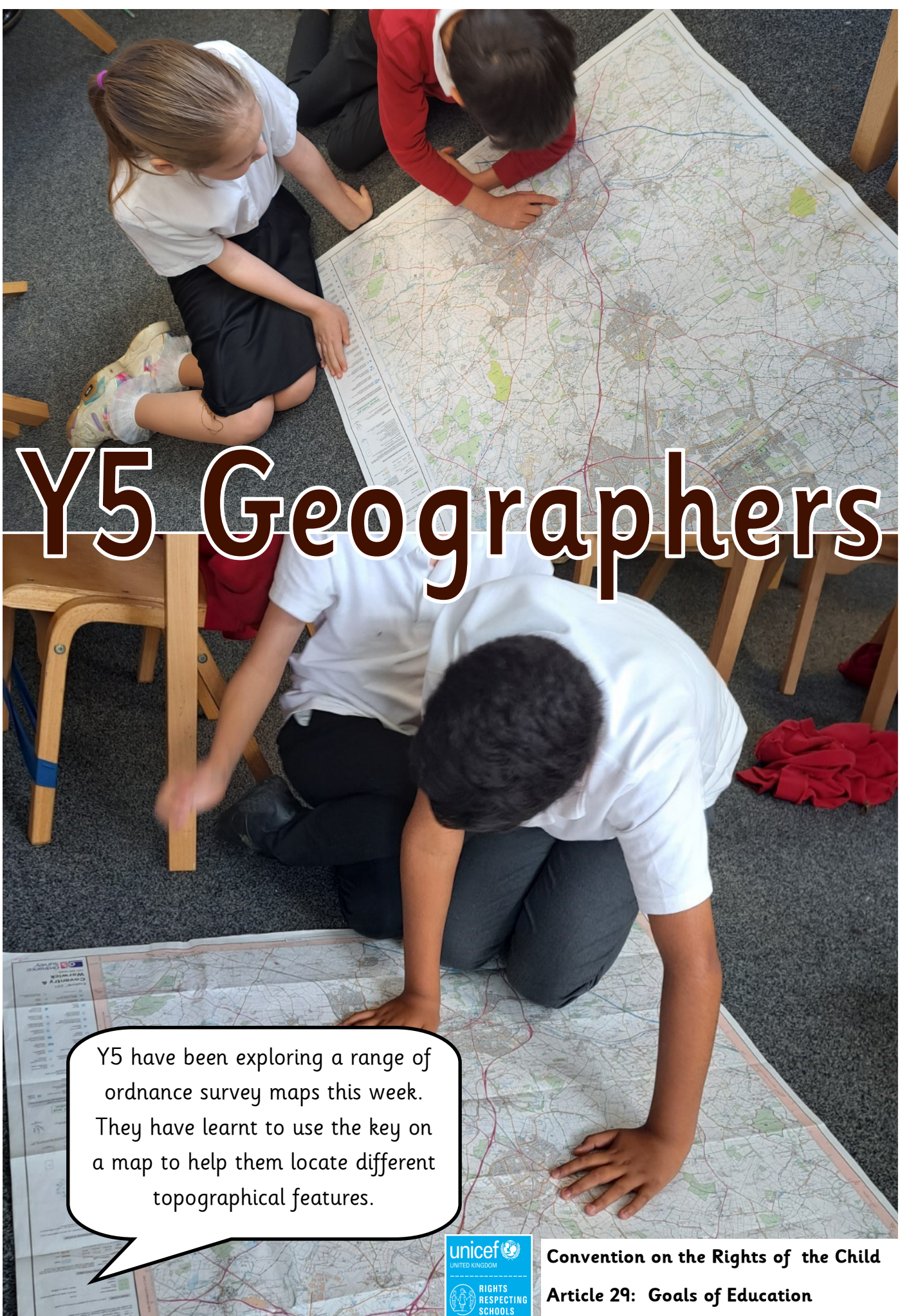

Y5 have been exploring a range of ordnance survey maps this week. They have learnt to use the key on a map to help them locate different topographical features.



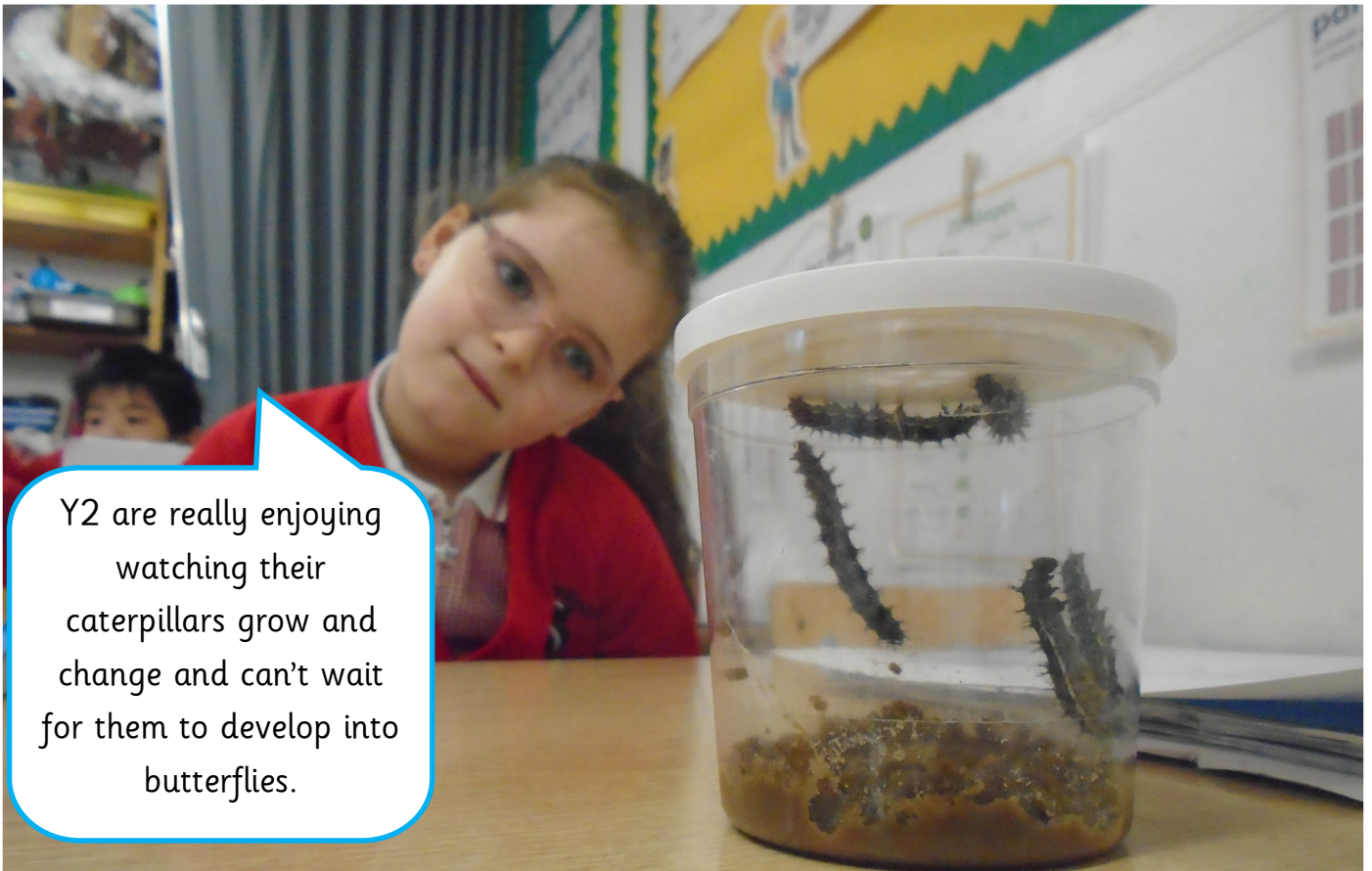

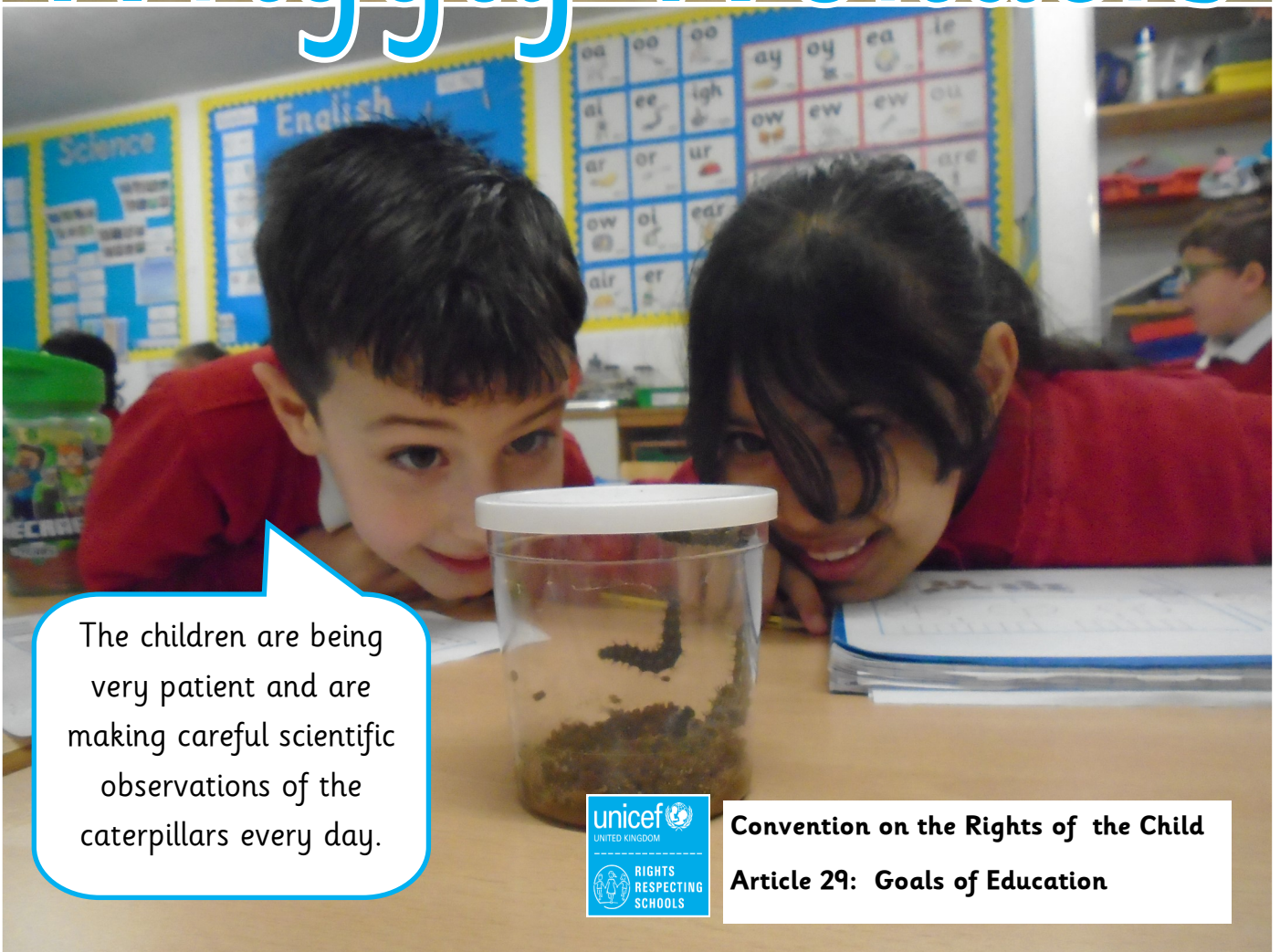


Y2 Make a Splash

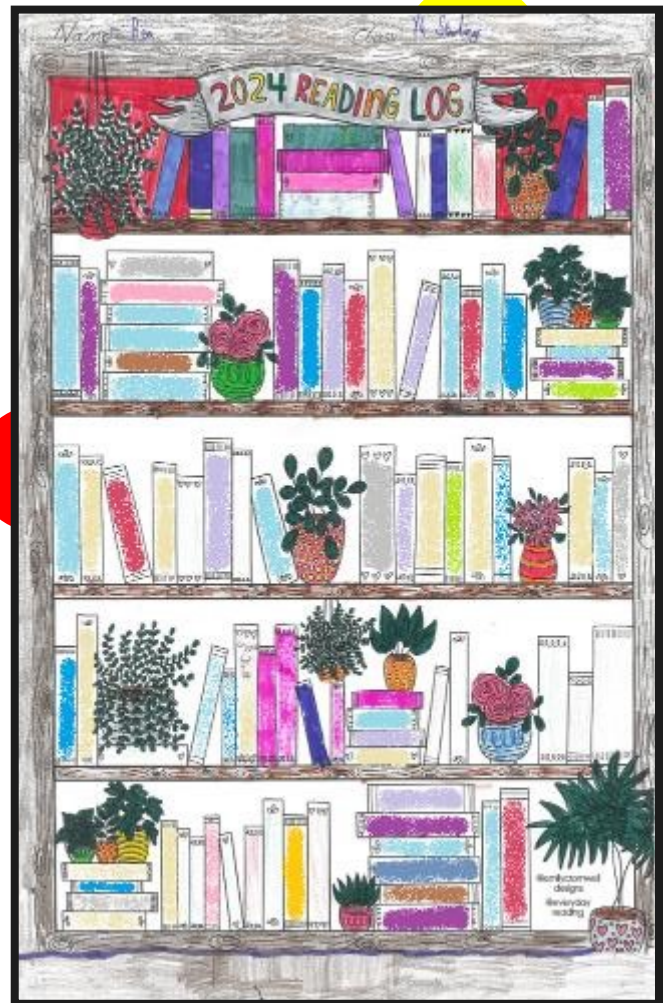
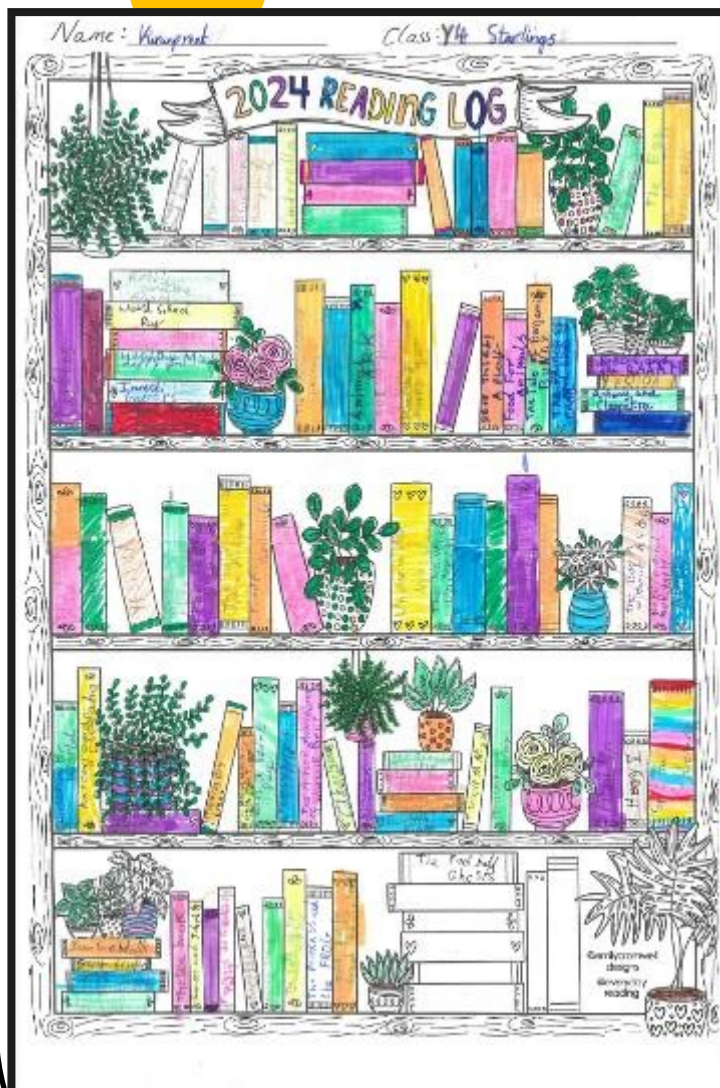


William Morris
