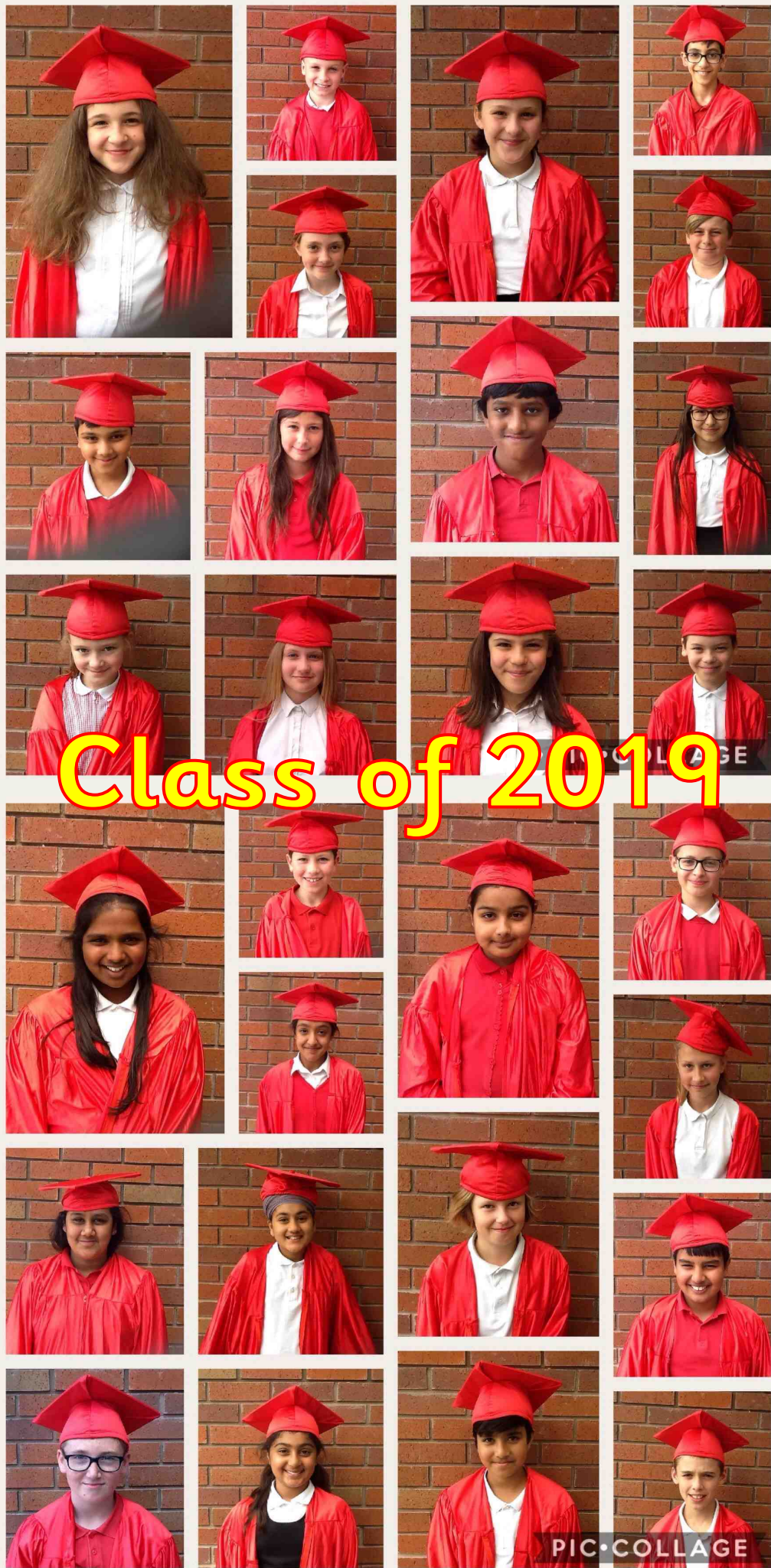

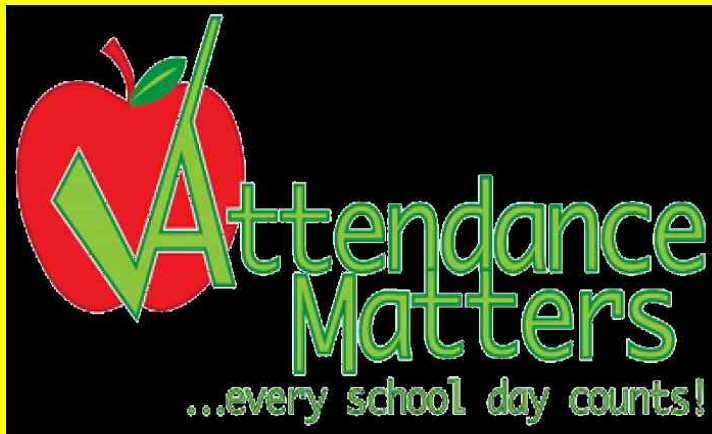
Reception's BIG Picnic

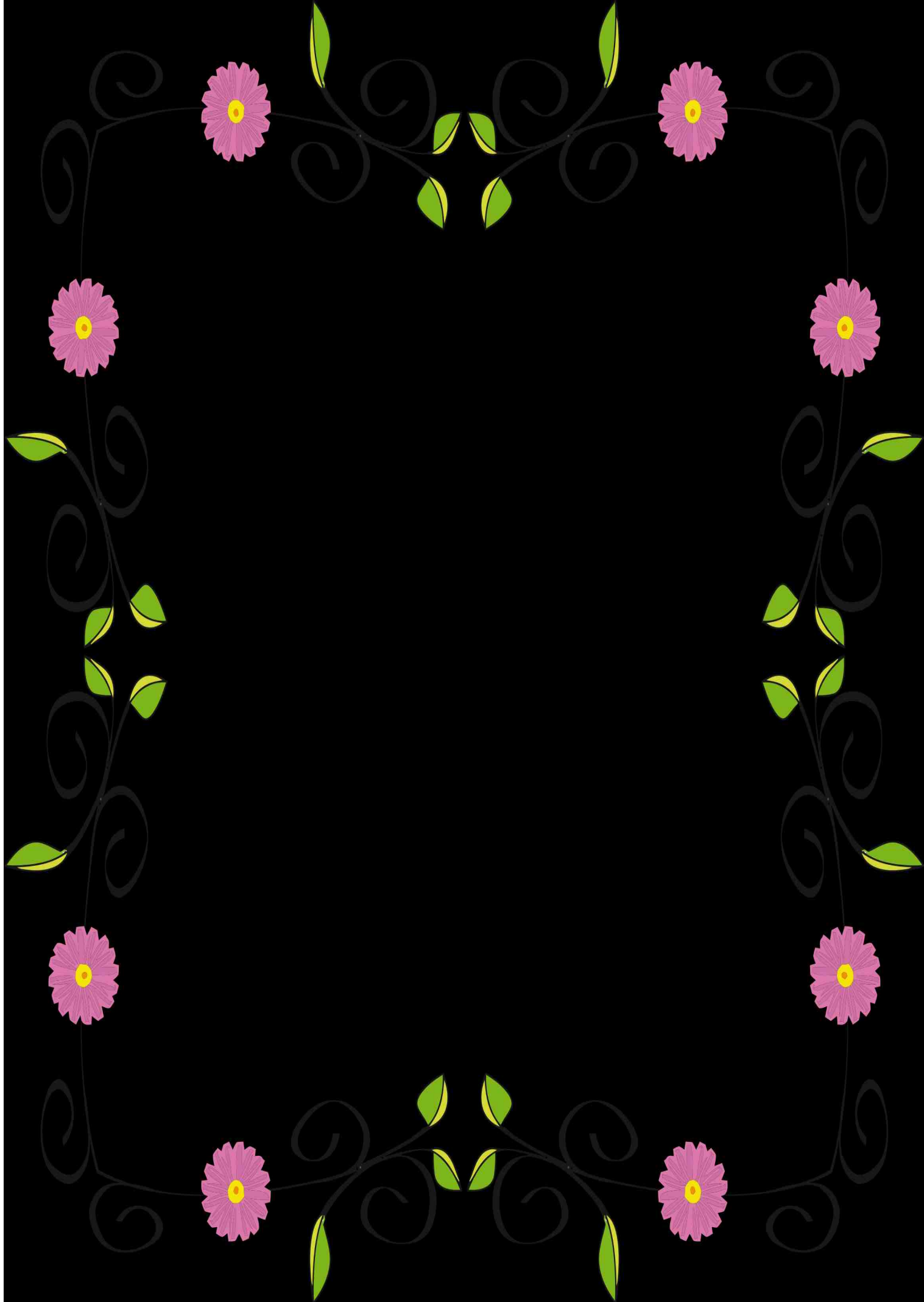
