Unfortunately, Over the last two weeks many children have still been arriving late to school, some on a regular basis. Lateness is very disruptive to your child's learning. Although we understand that sometimes unexpected things happen that can make people late, it is important that everyone makes every effort to get to school on time. School begins at 8.55 and children come straight in so teachers can do the register. The children themselves report that it can be embarrassing and uncomfortable to have to walk into the classroom when everyone is already sat down quietly. It also means that it is harder for children to settle into their learning properly. Sometimes lessons and activities begin immediately and missing the beginning can mean your child doesn't know what to do and has to have things explained to them again separately. It can also be disruptive to the rest of the class. We hope that punctuality will improve over the next few weeks. Thank you for your cooperation.
