## **Important Building Project News**

Dear parents and carers,

As you know, the County Council has been planning to develop our school site, as we are in a process of expansion. We have just been informed that the first stage of the building development programme is beginning on Monday 18th March. The contractors will be working in the small front playground and we will not be able to use it at all.

**Please read this information carefully, as it explains arrangements for you and your child/children, including those in the Purple Playhouse.**

### **Start of day**

Once for children and parents onto the school site will be through the red gate next to the road entrance. All children and adults will walk down the path and along the side of the school to the main playground at the back of the school.

Classes 1-6 will line up on the big playground. The children know where to line up.

Children and parents in the reception class will walk all the way round the outside of the school and wait in the reception outdoor classroom.

During this week children in the Purple Playhouse will come in and leave through the main school entrance.

### **End of day**

Children in Reception and KS1 will be collected from classrooms as normal. All parents will need to walk round the outside of the school.

Children in KS2 will be collected from the back playground.

Children in the Purple Playhouse will be using the main school entrance.

### **Throughout the day**

Children and parents using the Purple Playhouse will come in and leave through the main school entrance.

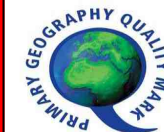
