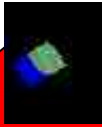

World Book Day



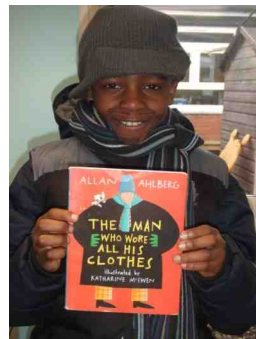
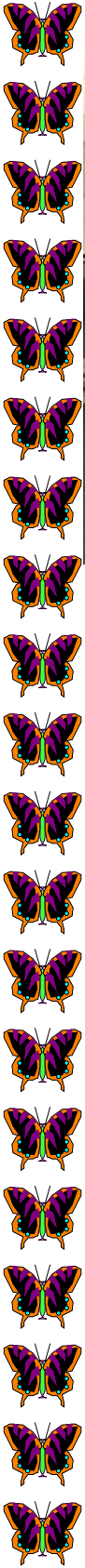
