On Thursday and Friday we held two fantastic KS2 concerts. The singing was amazing thanks to the expert tuition of Mrs Murphy and the hard work of the children.
























The audience was also treated to some skilled recorder playing featuring children in Years 4, 5 and 6.


Thank you to everyone who was able to attend these two events. We really appreciate your support and hope you enjoyed the children's musical talents.

Goodbye


