Unicef Award Rights' Respecting School



We are thrilled to announce that we have successfully achieved the Bronze Rights Respecting School Award in recognition of our work promoting and protecting children's human rights.

Information about the award

The Unicef UK Rights' Respecting Schools Award supports schools across the UK to embed children's human rights in their ethos and culture.

The Award recognises achievement in putting the UN Convention on the Right of the Child (CRC) at the heart of a school's practice to improve wellbeing and help all children and young people realise their potential.

The Award is based on principles of equality, dignity, respect, non-discrimination and participation. The initiative started in 2006 and schools involved in the Award have reported a positive impact on relationships and wellbeing, leading to better learning and behaviour and improved academic standards.

In the words of a Rights' Respecting pupil:

"A Rights Respecting School is a place where we can all feel confident with ourselves and it encourages us to use our voice. It has helped me build my confidence. It has helped me raise awareness of injustice in the world."



Happy Vaisakhi!

It was a special time for Sikhs on April 13th and 14th when they celebrated the festival of Vaisakhi. Hindus also celebrate Vaisakhi.

For Sikhs, Vaisakhi commemorates the foundation of the Khalsa community. As part of the celebrations, Sikhs decorate their local Gurdwara, gather together to socialise and share festive food. In the Punjab, Vaisakhi also marks the start of the Spring harvest festival.

Reception pupils had great fun learning about the festival in class. As well as dressing up in traditional Indian clothing they enjoyed dancing and learning about the Sikh gurus.

Changes to Data Collection

The law about how we collect and store your personal details is changing on May 25th 2018.

In order to be compliant with the new General Data Protection Regulations, we are in the process of amending some of our data collection sheets. Today (Friday 20th April) your child brought home a Consent Form for the Recording and Use of Images. **It is very important that you fill in and return this form, completing all of the yes/no questions.** Completion of this form is a legal requirement so it is imperative that you fill in the form and hand it in at the school office as soon as possible.


Y4/5/6 Kayaking Club
