



# YR AH Class Assembly "Whatever Next!"

## Getting there

Leamington is easily accessible from multiple major roads such as the M40, M6, M1, A46 and the Fosse Way.

The Festival will be held at the **Pump Room Gardens,**  
The Parade, Leamington Spa,  
CV32 4AA

**Trains:** The nearest train station is Leamington Spa which is a 10 minute walk from the festival.

**Buses:** Most buses to Leamington Town Centre stop on The Parade, which is less than a 10 minute walk to the festival. For more information contact 02476 559 559.

**Taxis:** There is a taxi rank less than a 5 minute walk away from the festival, located just off The Parade near the Police Station.

**Bikes:** There are provisions for locking bikes outside the Pump Rooms. All bikes are left at the owners own risk.



## Parking

There is a **free car park** which is only a two minute walk from the festival, located at:  
Warwick District Council  
Riverside House, Milverton  
Hill, CV32 5HZ  
Open from 07:00 - 19:00

Parking in the Royal Priory Car park is **£1.20** for the entire day on a Sunday and the car park is a short five minute walk to the festival location, which will be visible from The Parade.

A 10 minute walk at the top of The Parade is the Covent Garden car park.

There is also St Peters Car Park which is opposite the festival.

**There is no car parking on the Festival site.**

Please note: All town centre parking is Pay and Display.
