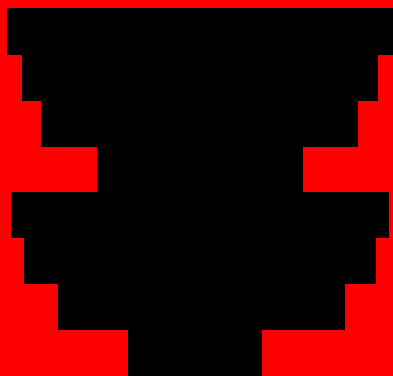

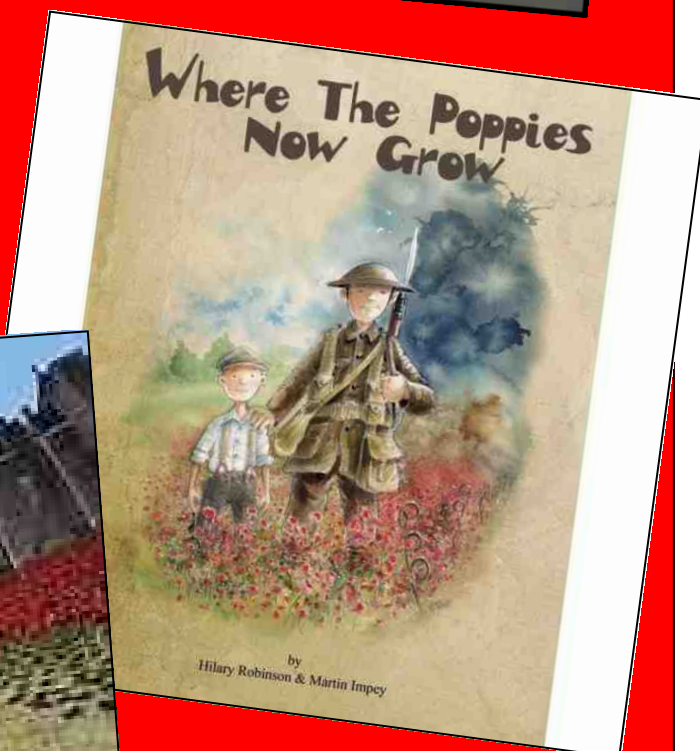


Looking at Learning ~ Armistice Day

Last week pupils took part in a series of assemblies to commemorate Armistice Day. On Monday 10th November, Mrs Westwood led an assembly to introduce the idea of Remembrance and Peace. Year 2 pupil, Ben O'Donnell, brought in badges from his father who was a bomb disposal [REDACTED]

On Monday afternoon pupils in KS2, along with other pupils across the country, watched a live streaming of Remembrance from the Tower of London. They saw images of the poppies and heard from the artist who designed them. They also watched interviews with war veterans and listened to poems and speeches.

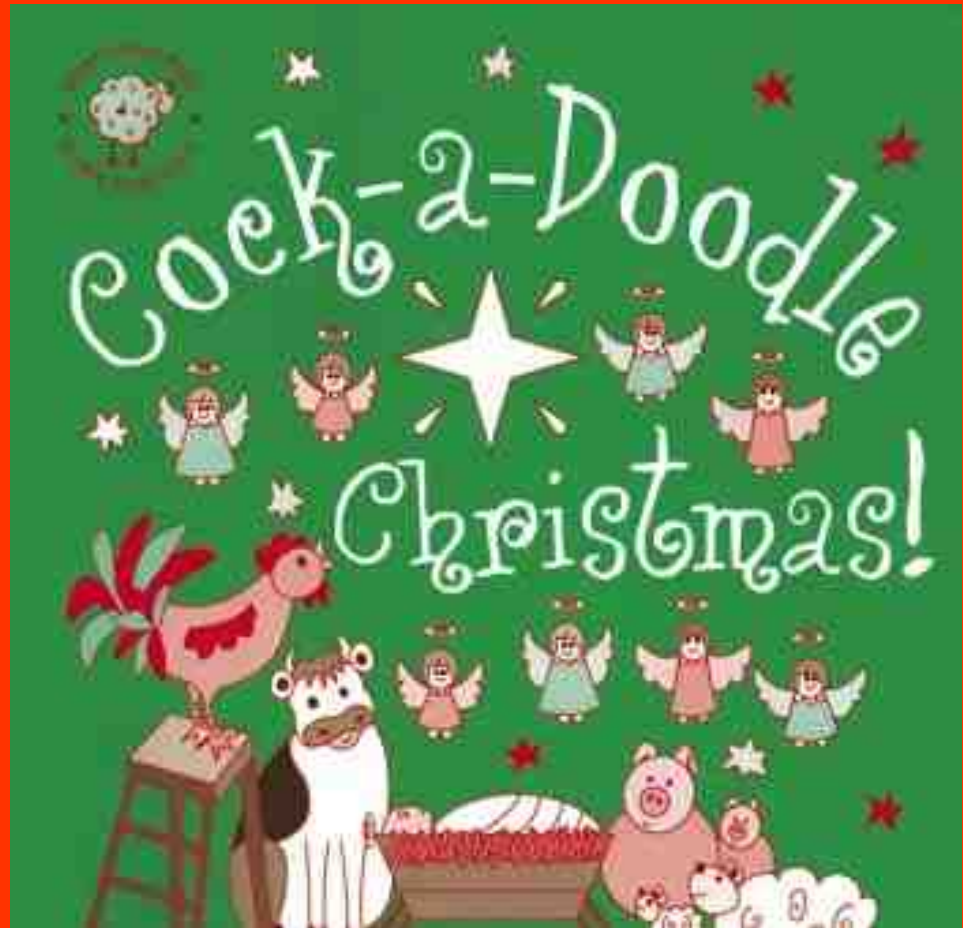
