Monday started with another Lego Innovation training day for all the teaching staff. This will enable our staff to support the children when our new Innovation Studio based here at the school opens after the half term.

<u>Clubs</u>

Extra-curricular activities are an important element of our provision at Sydenham Primary School. They offer a wealth of opportunities outside of the curriculum for students to develop skills, broaden their experiences and make friends with students from other form and year groups, whilst most importantly, having fun. Some of these activities are funded by the Sports Premium—our 3 new Table Tennis Tables for example which the children are making full use of during breaktimes.
