Free School Meals

If your situation has recently changed or you feel you may be entitled to Free School Meals for your child, it is very easy to apply.

You can also ask in the office for additional guidance or assistance. Please note that you do not have to take up your entitlement every day, if you have applied, but eligibility makes a huge difference to the way our school is funded. Please apply if you can.

Building Works

Ashe Construction will be back on our school site for 3 weeks (commencing Monday 3rd February 2014) to complete the playground works and some additional internal building works. We are looking forward to having an open day when all the work is finished, so that parents and carers can come and have a peek at our new accommodation.

Refurbishment of Year R/1& 2 toilets.

We are pleased to announce that the Reception, Year 1 & Year 2 boys and girls toilets will be refurbished during the Easter Holidays. This work alone will cost in excess of £25,000. This financial year, we received £6,273 for capital projects (building/maintenance/ICT projects). As you can see this funding does not go far in maintaining the building, and leaves a significant amount of money to find from other revenue streams. The work that I, and other members of the teaching staff do to support other Warwickshire schools, generates additional income that enables us to fund extra staff, resources and capital projects. We would love to be able to refurbish all of the toilets but, as you can imagine, our highest prioirity is always the children's achievement and ensuring that our resources enable children to do their very best learning.
