Jermaine," There are challenges to do, for instance you might only be allowed to use green or blue, or yellow and pink. Levels go from 1-6a.






Klaudia," My favourite thing was climbing. I always got to the top. We also pulled people up to the top to help them and pulled them down with the ropes to help them get down.
