RIGHTS RESPECTING SCHOOLS

- 1. We come to school every day and arrive on time
- 2. We work hard and always do our best ~ *we don't waste our own or* others' time
- 3. We are gentle ~ *we don't hurt others*
- 4. We are kind and helpful ~ we don't hurt anybody's feelings
- 5. We are honest \sim we don't cover up the truth
- 6. We listen ~ *we don't interrupt*
- 7. We look after property ~ we don't waste or damage things
- 8. We look after each other

Rewards:

- 1. Verbal praise
- 3. Stickers
- 2. Written praise 4. Certificates
- 5. Letters home
- 6. Golden Time
- 7. Five minutes' extra play (class reward from lunchtime supervisors)

Sanctions~ what will happen if you *choose* not to follow the rules:

Classroom

<u>1st time</u>: verbal warning 2nd time: moved to another part of the classroom <u>3rd time</u>: go for 10 minutes' 'time out' in another classroom (recorded in class behaviour book) <u>4th time</u>: missed playtime, supervised by class teacher <u>5th time</u>: sent to Associate Head or Executive Head Teacher <u>6th time</u>: contact parents/carers.

Lunch time

<u>1st time</u>: verbal warning 2nd time: stand with supervisor for 10 minutes <u>3rd time</u>: go to Senior Midday Supervisor to discuss misbehavour. misbehaviour recorded in 4th Time: go to Associate Head or Executive Head Teacher for 'time out' of the playground. <u>5th Time</u>: if the behaviour persists, contact parents/carers.
