Our next small gift to the children is a sewing kit, containing a square of binka fabric, an embroidery needle and a skein of embroidery thread. Sewing is a fantastic activity for practising 'mindfulness' because you have to really concentrate! It's quite tricky, and your child will have to really persevere! Below is a picture of the stitches you can try first of all. Ask your child to start with a simple running stitch (the top red one), and progress to cross stitch (the green one). Your child will need a pair of scissors to cut the thread, and you may need to help them to thread their needle.
