

Last Friday, Y3 visited Cadbury World as part of their topic, "Scrumdiddlyumtious."


The children had a fantastic time tasting and tempering chocolate, learning about the history of Cadbury's and exploring the origins of chocolate.

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

Parent Information Sessions/ Coffee Chats
