

CARING

There are lots of different ways to be caring and show that you care. This can be offering help to another person, being curious about others and their lives, showing genuine concern for others and being there to listen.

One small act can have a bigger impact than we realise, it could inspire others to do the same and contribute to making the world a better place.

Taking the time to be compassionate and show that you care will not only positively impact others but will internally boost your own self-esteem and wellbeing. This can bring us closer to each other and provide us with a sense of belonging, purpose and trust in others.

Our tips for caring:

1- Caring Chain

Pupils each to write down an act of caring they can do for another person or for themselves on a strip of paper. Create a paper chain with each of these strips by folding and linking them together. This can then be displayed in the classroom and pupils can be encouraged to give a new act of caring a go each week.

2- Try to identify 3 ways you have been caring towards yourself and 3 ways you have been caring towards others. Then set a goal for another caring act you can carry out over the following week.
