


















# Swans Class























Last week, Y5 pupils spent two days in London, visiting The Imperial War Museum and sleeping on HMS Belfast which is moored on the River Thames. The residential trip was linked to the pupils' History topic on World War Two.



HMS Belfast played a vital role in key naval operations during the 20th century, including the D-Day landings and the Arctic convoys of World War II. Today, she serves as a floating museum, offering visitors a powerful insight into life at sea during wartime. From her gun turrets to the engine rooms, HMS Belfast tells the story of the sailors who served aboard her and preserves an important chapter of British maritime history.

On board HMS Belfast, pupils enjoyed special lessons and a tour of the ship—they even slept in the original sailors' bunks! Pupils were fascinated to learn about the history of the ship and the hardships that naval personnel faced during active service. At The Imperial War Museum, the children toured various galleries, learning about different aspects of The Second World War. Afterwards, as a special treat, everyone rode on the London Eye and had fun spotting famous landmarks in our capital city.

What a wonderful residential visit!










# Y6 Silent Disco






#### Here are some tips from Public Health Warwickshire to keep well in the sun and heat:
